MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 19TH MEETING

- 9:50 am Meeting Commenced. Important dates were reviewed with the board by Dilara Khalilova, including names of chairs for each event, location, fees, and deadlines. (Please see above for this information).
- 10:30 New category suggestion for the scholarship competition from Regina Verteym. This would create a 4th category for piano, for ages 7-9, so that ages 7-12 are no longer lumped together. Discussion ensued concerning cost and logistics of such a move. Our treasurer Laura Halliday explained that the extra monetary prizes for the new category would be possible (though exact amounts are still to be determined—perhaps \$50 for 1st place and \$25 for 2nd). Motion was made for creation of such a category, and motion was seconded. All were in favor.
- 10:45 Discussion of finances for festivals, CM and possible addition of a 3rd place prize for high school students participating in the Scholarship Competition. We need more info. on this from our treasurer.
- 11:00 Discussion about whether or not contributing members can enter students in our branch's scholarship competition. We must check the By-laws for this.
- 11:10 Discussion about difficulties associated with timing as concerns the Honors Recital. Because there is so little time between the CM and the Honors Recital, the Chair, Roger Eshleman, is often overwhelmed. It was decided that moving forward, any and all students who are eligible for performing in the honors recital must respond with a "yes" or "no" by 10 pm on the Tuesday after CM weekend (in this case the 19th of March). This deadline must be strictly adhered to!
