Teachers can purchase the *CM Syllabi* online via the MTAC website at www.mtac.org, under "Shopping" or can order directly from the MTAC State Office. The *CM Syllabi* are not available in electronic format.

## **Branch CM Information Meeting**

The Certificate of Merit program administration can be complex, so the easiest way to work through all the details is to attend your Branch CM Information Meeting.

The CM Information Meeting for our Branch will be held on Monday, September 24, 2012 at Piano Play from 9:00-9:45 am. Topic of discussion: CM Syllabus, CM calendar of events and Teacher's Work Contracts.

If you cannot attend the Branch CM Information Meeting, please contact your CM Branch Chairs at pianopam@gmail.com or shshaheed@aol.com as soon as possible for approved alternatives.

Teachers who do not attend the meeting may be at risk for registering their students in CM via the online registration system, and may risk having student registrations dropped automatically.

## When do I register my students in CM?

Teachers register students online during the registration period, which **starts on September 15** and **ends on November 15**. Specific instructions are contained in the *2012 CM Policies and Procedures*, and will also be emailed to you soon. If you do not have internet access, you will need to find a colleague CM teacher who has access and can assist you in obtaining the documents and registering your students. No late registrations are allowed; no exceptions.

## **Working at CM Evaluations**

Each Branch organizes and administrates its own CM Evaluations, which may take place on one day or several days depending on each Branch's participation numbers and facilities. As CM depends 100% on volunteers, participating teachers are required to fulfill Branch volunteer hours to help the Branch administrate CM during CM Evaluations. Beyond the minimum requirement, many teachers often volunteer their time throughout the entire year – before, during, and after CM Evaluations – to ensure a great experience for all teachers and students in our Branch. Volunteering at CM provides teachers significant benefits to their studio businesses as their students benefit from a high-level experience of service and programming, gain a deeper understanding of the CM program from different perspectives, and work towards a common musical goal within their local communities.

Teachers who do not fulfill their Branch requirement of volunteer hours must pay a non-work fee to help the Branch administrate CM with a reduced number of volunteers. Non-work fees vary from Branch to Branch. Teachers will be sent a Teacher Work Agreement to fill out and return with their registration and fees.
