There is no time limit for teachers - no limit on the amount of students any teacher may enter.

Students may play any number of pieces from the Romantic or the Classical Eras or any combination of both as long as the time does not exceed 6 minutes.

More advanced students may play one long movement of a Classical or a Romantic piece even if it exceeds 6 minutes.
